Employment

Every worker has the right to equal treatment.

Scottish Greens' policies cover all the activities that people undertake to support themselves, their families and communities. Individual workers need protection under the law – basic rights for employees, support for the self-employed and small businesses, and a charter for volunteers and carers.

Employee Rights

All employees have the right to dignity at work, just conditions of work, a fair wage and security of employment from the start of their employment. Casual work and short-term contracts shall not be used as a way of avoiding statutory rights. All workers have a right to union membership, including the police, security and armed services.

Scottish Greens

- support the organisation of workers in trade unions and in workers' co-operatives;
- campaign for the UK to reduce working hours to 35 per week. We will make 28 days paid holiday a year plus public holidays a legal right;
- encourage the growth of Employee Share Ownership Plans and the democratisation of Pension Funds;
- recognise the right to take industrial action without being in breach of contract or threatened with dismissal and will repeal all legislation that outlaws secondary industrial action (secondary picketing and sympathy strikes).

Job Sharing

Excessive working hours contribute to stress, ill health, lower productivity and poorer quality of life. Scottish Greens encourage job-sharing, flexible and part-time working, career breaks and the provision of workplace childcare.

Many organisations and communities rely on the work of volunteers and Greens will encourage volunteering, and recognise it as contributing towards relevant vocational and educational qualifications.

Small Businesses

To compensate for inequalities of power, Greens will introduce a statutory code protecting employees and revise contract law to protect small businesses and the self-employed.

Scottish Greens will encourage local authorities to use their power as suppliers, purchasers and contractors to promote local small businesses and enable them to tender for contracts.

Green Collar Jobs

Green collar work is the fastest growing sector of the economy. We will support the growth of the sustainable Green economy.

Scottish Greens encourage plans for the conversion of military and other unsustainable industries to socially useful and environmentally friendly production.
