# Who are the Greens?

Scottish Green Party members know that politics is important – too important to leave to the old grey parties.

The credit crunch has been caused by a runaway, unsustainable economic bubble – growth at any price. Progress should be measured in terms of quality of life. We believe that high quality, publicly owned services – education, public transport, health, water – should be available to all.

We want to make a difference. Scottish Greens represent a new politics, based on a hopeful but realistic vision for Scotland. Green politics puts people first.

SGP has elected members in local Councils and the Scottish Parliament. SGP members are active on Community Councils across Scotland, and work with the UK Green MEPs in Europe. At all levels, Scottish Greens make a difference. Join us – you can help make that difference.

## Green Scotland

The Green economy is the economy of the future. Scotland can end the blight of persistent poverty by building a high-skill, low-carbon economy.

We need to be able to live in comfort, without taking the world's resources away from our children.

A Green works programme to insulate every home in Scotland over ten years would, at a stroke, create jobs, address fuel poverty, reduce energy demand and make progress towards the government's own carbon reduction targets.

So why have successive governments – Labour/ LibDems, SNP/Tory refused to endorse it?

Climate change is now accepted as the most serious problem we face. We need international action – and we need a government here in Scotland which is prepared to prioritise carbon reduction, now.

Sustainability is at the core of Green politics.

Scottish Greens work in parliament and their communities for social justice, tolerance, a healthy environment, and internationally for peace and the rule of law. Greens believe that Scotland has no need of weapons of mass destruction and oppose Trident nuclear weapons. We support a range of measures to redistribute wealth and reduce poverty at home and internationally.

We seek a radical, empowering democracy where everyone is able to take an equal part in the decisions which affect them. We support an independence referendum to let the Scottish people decide – but the priority for Greens is to empower communities and people.
